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Beginner Trip to the Boundary Waters



Trip Details

Skill Level: Easy

Departs: May through September

Length: 3 Days

Cost: \$299/person (\$60/person each additional day)

If this is your first time to the Boundary Waters or if you are bringing smaller children this is the trip for you! After a briefing with us at Seagull we would

transport you by van south of us about 5 miles to start your trip at the Cross Bay entry point. Set up your base camp here or if you wish paddle on to Long Island Lake. This is an area of small lakes and short portages. Watch for moose in the shallows as evening sets in. Go swimming on the sand beach on Long Island Lake or fish the many rapids that connect the lakes. Paddle back to a van pickup at the Cross Bay entry point.
