A fly-in trip to Clay Lake with a base camp on Mack Lake can offer you just what you're looking for. And you're in for an extra special treat if fishing is your pleasure. Mack Lake holds some of the best trophy walleye and bass fishing in the area. Depending on your time constraints, you may opt for the return flight home. But if you're feeling more adventurous, take a couple days and paddle and portage your way back to civilization and get a close up of the vast wilderness that makes this area so appealing. Whichever you decide, you'll be sure to see far less people and far more wildlife than you did on your last visit to the canoe country.
